

Public Notice for the Intent to Apply for the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ARP ESSER III) Grant

The Henry Ford Academy Charter School is making a public notice for the intent to apply for the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ARP ESSER III) Grant. The purpose of the ARP ESSER III is to address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on students by combating learning losses, supporting social-emotional needs, and ensuring a safe return to the school environment.

General Specifics on the grant are as follows:

- Time Frame for the grant: March 13, 2020 through September 30, 2023
- Required to follow all federal, state and local regulations and requirements for federal grant administration and fiscal spending of funds
- Henry Ford Academy Charter School entitlement for the grant for the 3-year period: \$266,430
